New Masking Guidelines and Other Protocols as of 6/28/21

Following Pennsylvania state guidelines:

Masks Are Now Optional Throughout the Building

However, some instructors may still require a face covering inside their lesson room. Ask your teacher about their individual policy.

If you are not vaccinated, we encourage you to still wear a face covering. A box of disposable masks is on the table just inside the main entrance.

If you are not fully vaccinated and need to quarantine, please do so – do not enter if you

- Have a cough, fever or are not feeling well
- Have been in contact with someone who has coronavirus
- Have recently been to an area where there is a high amount of COVID-19 cases (see the list of states on the health.pa.gov website)
- Have tested positive for COVID-19, obviously, and have not yet received the OK from your doctor that you are virus-free and clear to leave home

In these cases, lessons can be conducted online until you are feeling better or have completed quarantine.

In an effort to keep traffic flow to a minimum and provide a safe environment for everyone:

Everyone should wait in their vehicle before the lesson and not linger afterwards

Parents may remain in the building during the lesson. The big room has been arranged in a way to promote distancing – chairs spread out, kids' table removed, etc.

All lessons and meetings are by appointment only

Hand sanitizer and cleaning supplies are available throughout the building.
